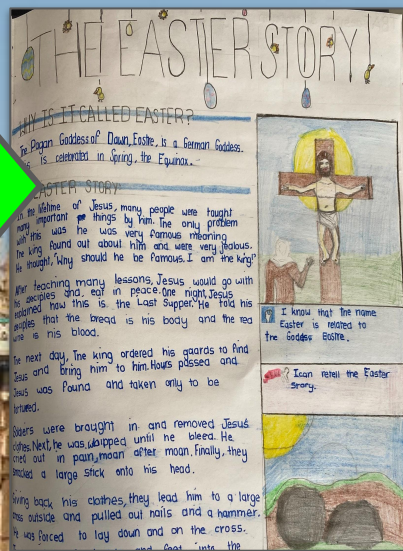
In English, we have been writing letters, diary entries and descriptions. This is Sophia's description.

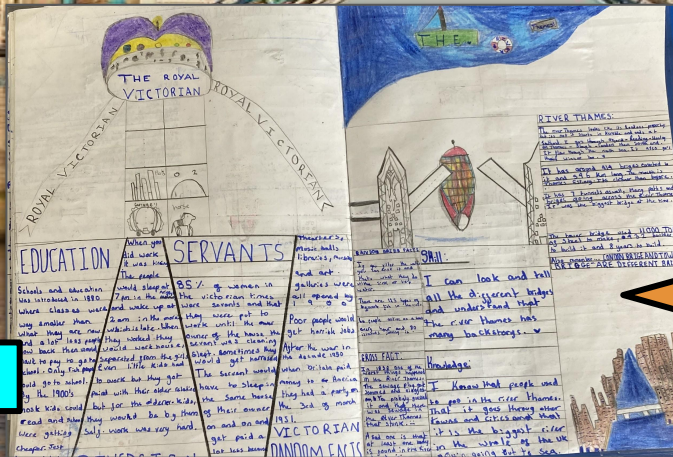
