English

Home Learning Menu

Home Learning includes reading, numbots or TT Rockstars & Spelling. Optional projects are detailed on the Home Learning Menu which is uploaded into google classroom.

Numbots: Children can access this at home. Log in details are in their Yellow reading record books.

TT Rockstars: In Year 2, we focus on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. These can be practised on TT Rockstars. The log in details are the same for this as numbots.

Year 2 Term 5 - Magnificent Monarchs

Science

We will be learning about growth in animals by exploring the life cycles of some familiar animals. The children will build on learning about the survival of humans by identifying the basic needs of animals for survival, including food, water, air and shelter.

DT

The children will be learning about three types of mechanism: sliders, levers and linkages. The Children will be making their own models of each mechanisms.

Music

In music this term will will be learning about Jazz music and exploring pitch.

History

In History, we will investigate 'Power and Rule' and learn the sovereign timeline. There will be a look at different residences that the Royals use and we will have a particular focus on Alfred the Great, William the Conqueror, Henry VIII and Elizabeth I.

Computing

In computing we will be learning about coding and using a programme called Scratch.

PSHE

Children will be learning about 'Friendships' and the importance of cooperation, appreciation and trust.
