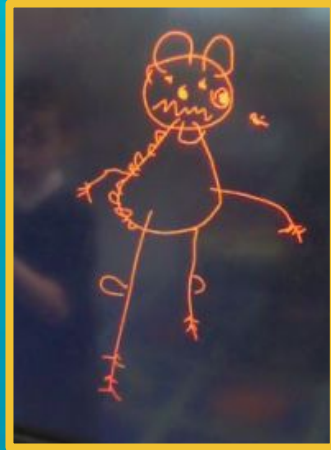




This Term we have been sharing Our Favourite Stories!

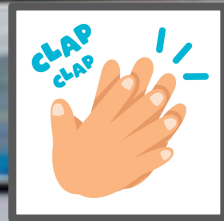
This is the Gruffalo.

Well done for an an amazing term. You should all be proud of yourself! Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!





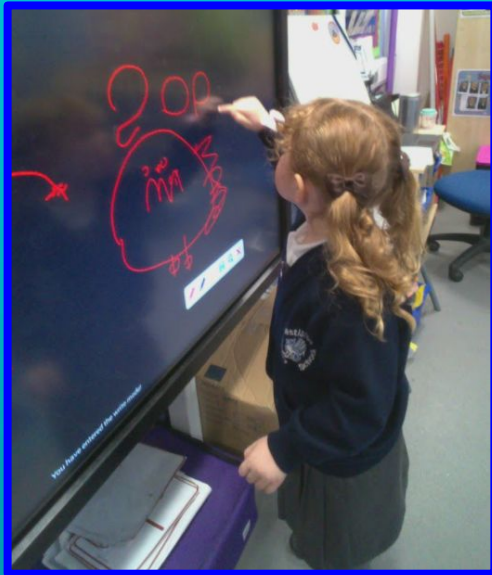
We have been retelling our favourite stories with drawings.

We had made a house from a Squash and a Squeeze.

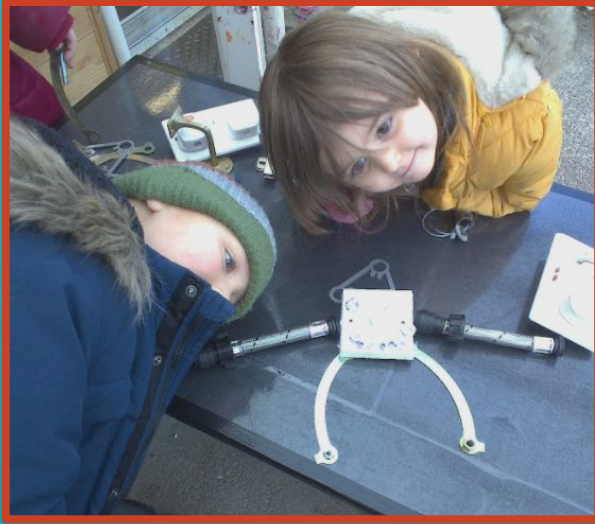


We used different construction to make a car.
