English:

Within our English lessons during Term 4 the children will learn how to write information texts. They will learn about poetic techniques and will create their own poems. Year 3 will also learn how to write a diary entry and will use drama and role-play to develop their creative writing skills.

Reading:

Throughout Term 4, Year 3 will be developing their understanding of how to answer retrieval, inference and choice questions from a range of texts. They will explore non fiction texts, including Pebble in my Pocket and also Escape from Pompeii. Both texts support our topic of Extreme Earth.

Maths:

Over Term 4, Year 3 will be learning all about fractions. They will learn about unit and non unit fractions, tenths, fractions as numbers, fractions of a set of objects and problems involving fractions. The children will continue to learn the 3,4 and 8 times tables.

Topic:

Topic lessons will bring a new understanding of our Earth. The children will learn about physical geography, use maps and atlases and also study a range of natural disasters. They will create their own exploding volcano and also learn about the water cycle.

Science:

During Term 4, the children will be studying plants. They will investigate how plants grow and what they need to survive. The children will also label and name parts of a plant and learn about their functions. They will also plant their own seeds and observe what happens!

Enrichment:

Over Term 4, Year 3 will be learning about volcanoes. They will work, as small teams, to design and create their own volcano! They will then create a volcanic eruption!
