1 I think that snow white means the doves and wonder in the woods.

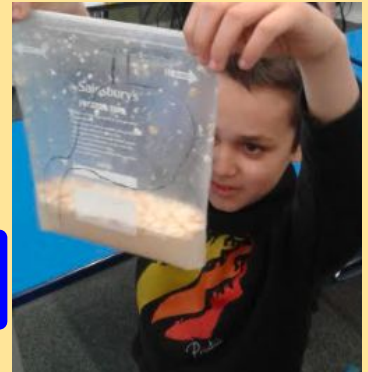

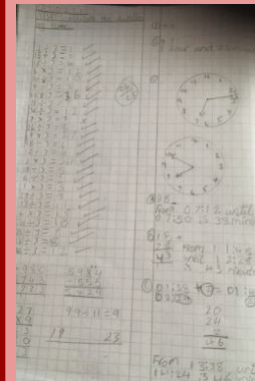
