A quick reference guide for parents and staff



What to do if.....	Action Needed	Return to school when....
...my child has covid-19 symptoms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Self isolate the whole household - Get a test 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The test comes back negative or a period of 10 days has passed since the symptoms started and the child feels well
...my child tests positive for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Agree an earliest date for return to school - Self isolate the whole household 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 10 days have passed since symptoms began, even if they still have a cough or loss of taste (these symptoms can last a long time) AND the child feels well
...my child tests negative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Contact school to inform us - Discuss when your child can come back (same day/next day) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The test comes back negative
...my child is ill with symptoms not linked with Covid -19 and could be contagious (ie sickness) or is too ill to come to school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Ring on each day of illness 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - After 48 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea (as per our policy)
... someone in my household has Covid 19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Self-isolate the whole household - Household member to get a test - Inform school immediately about test result 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The test comes back negative
... NHS test and trace has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid -19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum 14 days) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The child has completed 14 days of isolation
...NHS test and trace has identified a household member (other than my child) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The household member must self isolate for 14 days - Child can continue to come to school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child can continue to attend school
... a sibling attending another school has been sent home to self-isolate due to their being a positive case in the school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sibling must self-isolate for 14 days - Westlands Primary child/children can still attend 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child can continue to attend school
... my child has travelled abroad from a country or territory that is NOT on the exempt list of countries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If returning from a destination where quarantine is needed - Minimum of 14 days self isolation for all of those who travelled - Contact school to inform us you are back in the country and we will agree an earliest date for possible to return to school - Self -isolate the whole household <p>*Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) - For up to date travel information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The quarantine period of 14 days has been completed

<p>...my child has travelled abroad from a country or territory that IS on the exempt list of countries</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If returning from a destination where quarantine is NOT needed - Check the current Exempt countries and territories list to confirm the country you have travelled from or through is not on the exempt list. - Ring the school to inform us you have returned to the UK and agree a return date to school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You have informed the school of your return to the uk (<i>the office may ask you a few questions</i>)
<p>... I have travelled from a country that requires us to quarantine (but my child did not travel)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - As long as you do not have / have not had symptoms in the last 14 days, your child can continue to attend school - The person who has travelled must NOT leave the house, including to do pick up or drop off (please contact the school if you need support getting your child to school) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child can continue to attend school
<p>...we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Provide medical evidence to the school - Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - School inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again - You receive medical advice that your child may return to school
<p>...what if a family member has an operation and it is advised that they and their family need to self isolate</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not come to school - Contact school to inform us - Provide medical evidence to the school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The child has completed the advised self-isolation period
<p>...my child's bubble is closed due to a Covid - 19 outbreak in school</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Child must not come to school - Support your child at home with remote education provided by the school - Your child will need to self isolate for 14 days - Other siblings may continue to come to school - Child who is self isolating can not come on school grounds for pick up and drop off, please speak to the school if you need support 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - School inform you that the bubble will be reopened
<p>...I am unable to get a test for someone in the household who has symptoms</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If you are not able to get a test for the first 5 days of having symptoms, your child and anyone they live with must stay at home and self isolate for 14 days. Anyone in your support bubble must also stay at home 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The child has completed 14 days of isolation
