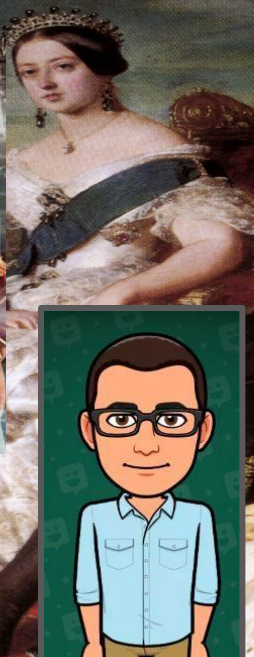


English -

We will be learning about fractions. Building on from fractions we will focus on fractions, decimals and percentages.

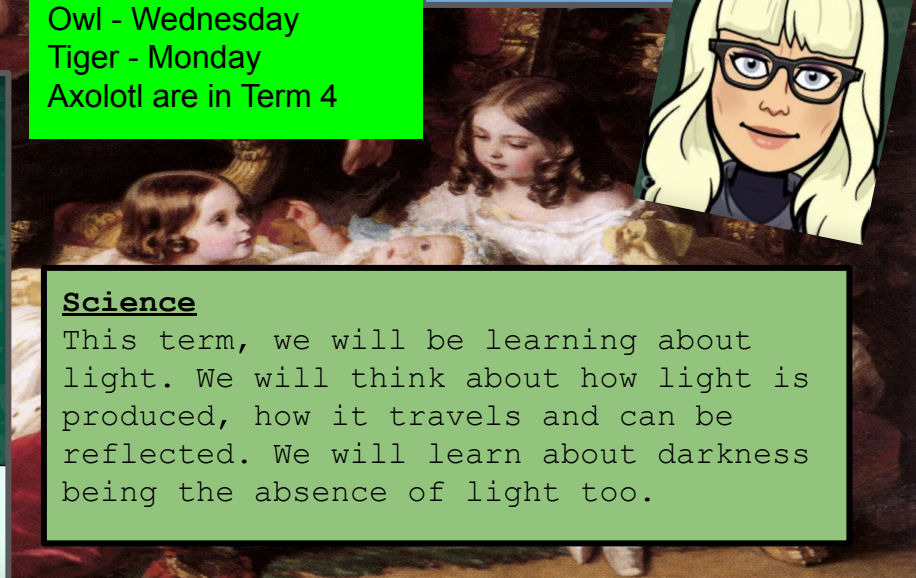
