Physical Education

Computing

In Term 4, children will be learning to input and handle data. They will learn to colour code data (formatting) and will then be able to filter the information to extract different criteria.

Throughout the week we will look to develop our body percussion knowledge.

PSHE

This term, we will focus on health education. The children will understand why it is important to adopt a healthy lifestyle. They will think about sleep, healthy eating, exercise, harmful habits and how to keep safe in person and online.

Religious Education

In R.E, Year 4 will be looking at SALVATION and considering 'why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?'
