

English

The children have daily phonics lessons using Little Wandle sessions to develop their understanding of phonics, their ability to spell and to develop reading skills.

The children also have a text-based lesson where they share ideas, build their vocabulary and practice their writing skills.

We will be writing reports, instructions, poems and recounts. Key learning in phonics and writing is to: hold a pencil correctly; sound out the sounds they can hear in a word; form letters correctly; say and then write a sentence or sentences!

Maths

The children will develop their understanding of numbers to 20 and their value. We will be sorting objects and numbers and will develop their understanding of addition and subtraction, learning the place value of these numbers. We will be learning to recognise and name 2D shapes.

Science

The Human Body - We learn to name and label body parts; investigate what parts of the body can do. We learn about sight, taste, smell, touch and hearing and develop our questioning and thinking skills through collecting data.

We will also develop our understanding of 'seasonal change' through observing how nature and weather change over the course of the year.

Freeflow- including Art and Design Technology, Geography and History

Our History learning teaches children about everyday life and families today, including comparisons with childhood in the 1950s using artifacts and a range of different sources. The children will develop their understanding of time, changes over time, how a timeline work and discuss chronological order.

Our Art we will explore using different materials to paint.

DT is developing food preparation skills through cookery as part of a 'Design a Sandwich' challenge.
