

English -

This term the children will continue to develop their phonic knowledge through daily lessons.

We will develop our writing skills to include a number of sentences using the correct punctuation, learning to write a report, a letter and retell parts of a story.

They will develop their skills in writing through learning about Sittingbourne and their school linking to their learning in history about schools during the Victorian period.

In handwriting, we will continue to develop cursive handwriting, correct orientation and formation of letters and consistency in size.

Science - This term the children will develop their knowledge and understanding of plants. They will be able to label a plant, learning what helps them to grow and observing their own plants growing with tender loving care.

Maths -

The children will continue to develop their knowledge of numbers to 50 moving on to 100 including number recognition, place value, addition and subtraction. They will count in 2s, 5s and 10s and be able to draw groups of numbers to lead into learning about multiplication and division. The children will begin to develop their understanding of how to find half of shapes and numbers.

Freeflow - including History, Geography and Art

The children will develop their understanding of their local area, focusing on schooling and compare life in a Victorian school to modern day education. We will learn how what a Victorian classroom looked like, what children learnt and how they had to behave.

They will begin to think about how we find out about the past and how things change over time. We will also learn a little about our paper making history and what it looked like here in Sittingbourne at that time in history.

At the end of the term, we will begin our Art focus learning about Dora Holzhandler, using her work to inspire our own 3D sculpture. We will develop our own piece of art using clay, learning a range of skills and techniques.
