### **English**

In English, over Term 3, the children are going to be focusing on writing narratives, poetry and instructions.

We will be exploring a range of texts including the lighthouse keepers lunch and traditional fairy tales.

## Year 2 Term 3

### Coastlines

#### **Home Learning**

Just a reminder that homework has ongoing projects which are sent out at the start of term as well as weekly spellings uploaded into google classroom.

Reading books will go home on Friday and must be returned on Wednesday.

#### **Geography**

In Geography this term, we are focusing on the coastline. It teaches children about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire.

### **Maths**

Within our Maths lessons, the children will be learning multiplication and division. There will be a focus on 2, 5 and 10x tables.

**Numbots:** Children can access this at home. Log in details are in their orange homework books.

**TT Rockstars:** In Year 2, we focus on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. These can be practised on TT Rockstars. The log in details are the same for this as numbots.

## Computing

Our focus for Term 3 is online safety. The children will be learning about how to be safe online and the potential risks to look out for.

## Religious Education

We will be looking at the Humanism and exploring their belief of treating others the way you wish to be treated.

## PSHE

This term in PSHE the children are going to be learning well-being. They will learn about their values and discuss feeling like gratitude and kindness.
