

English

The children have daily phonics sessions to develop their understanding of phonics, their ability to spell and to develop reading skills.

In our daily text-based lesson we share ideas, build vocabulary and practice core writing skills.

We will be writing stories, letters and information books this term based on our dinosaur theme!

Key learning in phonics and writing is to: sound out; form letters correctly; say and then write a series of sentences. We are challenging ourselves to write longer sentences using 'and' or 'but' and use simple adjectives and always reread our work.

Term 3 - Our Wonderful World!

Science

This term we explore the animals kingdom - naming and classifying animals; learning about their offspring and life cycles.

Linking our learning to dinosaurs and other animals, we will be learning whether they are carnivores or herbivores and where they live and why. We will develop our questioning and thinking skills and collecting data.

Maths

The children will develop their understanding of numbers to 50 and their value.

We will be measuring length and weight and consolidating our addition and subtraction skills and developing Place Value understanding.

Our learning is based across the subjects around our theme of 'Our Wonderful World'; the children will learn about Earth's features, maps, compass points and positional & directional language. We will also learn about the history of Earth focussing on the time of the dinosaurs: What was Earth like? How has Earth changed over time? We will also learn about Mary Anning, whose discoveries amazed the world!

In Art, we will focus on the artist, Georges Seurat, learning about painting: we will learn the primary colours, make secondary colours and investigate shades. We will also learn a range of techniques such as splattering and pointillism alongside painting on different materials, such as bubble wrap.
