

## English

Daily phonics lessons continue alongside our text based work around our woodland theme.

We are focusing on writing super sentences which make sense, using a full stop/exclamation mark or question mark and capital letters in the right places. We will also learn about nouns, adjectives and verbs! We will be explaining how to care for our forests, retell a woodland story and write instructions on how to plant seeds!

## Science

This term our science focus is enchanted woodlands. We will be learning about the animals you will find in British woodlands and their habitats. We will be looking at the parts of a plant and focusing on trees and how they grow. We will be investigating variation in animals such as butterflies and how amazing invertebrates are at burrowing! We are very excited to be exploring the woodlands at Capstone Country Park at the end of the term.

## Maths

The children will continue to develop their understanding of Place Value, for example in the number 39 there are 3 Tens and 9 Ones and the 3 represents 30 and the 9 just 9. We will begin adding and subtracting within 50 as the children secure their number bonds. We will also be investigating length & height, weight and volume.

## **Freeflow - including Geography, Art & Design and Technology**
