## **Home Learning**

## **Geography**

## **Maths**

Within our Maths lessons, the children will be learning Money, Shape, Length and Height. Allow your child to help you with money when out shopping to help learning or get them measuring things!

**TT Rockstars:** In Year 2, we focus on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. These can be practised on TT Rockstars. The log in details are the same for this as numbots.
