In English, over Term 1, the children will be given the opportunity to develop their creative writing skills. They will explore different ideas and techniques, such as employing expanded noun phrases, to add depth and excitement to their writing. They will be writing about their own created characters!

Science

In Science lessons, we will be exploring Animal Nutrition and the Skeletal System. The children will investigate animal diets, the requirements for life and the importance of a skeleton. They will also discover that not all skeletal systems are the same!

History

During our History lessons, the children will learn about The Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. They will develop an understanding of how this significant time period has shaped our lives today. They will study places such as Skara Brae and Stonehenge.

Maths

Within our Maths lessons, the children will begin their learning by being able to represent numbers.

As they move through the term they will also deepen their understanding of number by studying partitioning numbers and understanding 1, 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.

Term One Year 3 Through The Ages

Computing

Our focus for Term One, in computing, is Online Safety. The children will consider what online safety means and how they can be safe online.

French

The children will learn about France and greetings within Term One. They will also begin to learn some core vocabulary, for example, counting to 10.

PSHE
