Curriculum Driver Activities - Invasions - Term 1

Here is a list of suggested activities which you can complete at home. You can choose one of these a week and can bring your completed activity into school. You can decide how to present these - in your homework book, photos, models - it is up to you. Dojo points are up for grabs!

Subject	Suggested Activity	Dojo Points available:
History	Choose to write a letter, create an artefact or draw a picture of an aspect of historical Roman Britain or the period of the Anglo Saxons. You can use google to help you.	10
Geography	Draw a map to show where the Norse Lands are located in the world. Don't forget to name them with the names that we now know them as.	10
Art	Using different drawing mediums, create a still life drawing using the drawing techniques taught in Art week. For example, draw a picture of your favourite objects.	10
DT	Design your own ship that could be used for invading. Think carefully about what you would need to include. Research Viking ships to help your ideas!	10
Imagination	Imagine being a Roman soldier, returning to Rome from Britain to defend your homelands. Write a poem or story that shows you understand how it felt.	10
Science	Create your own investigation where you will compare objects from around your home and classify them as magnetic and non-magnetic. You can share these results in a method of your choice.	10
Music	Record yourself singing 'Mamma Mia' and send the video in on Dojo.	10
RE	Design and create your own Diwali lanterns - think carefully about the patterns that you could incorporate.	10
