We have been exploring our senses in the messy play.



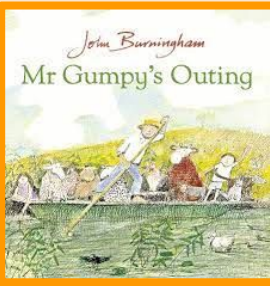
We have been junk modelling.

We retold the story in front of our friends.

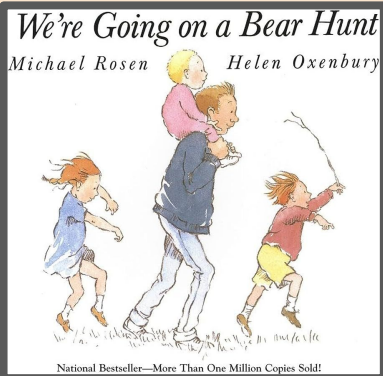


Let's explore

We have enjoyed retelling the story 'We're going on a bear hunt'. We planned our own walk to find the bear and enjoyed the sensory paths we made.

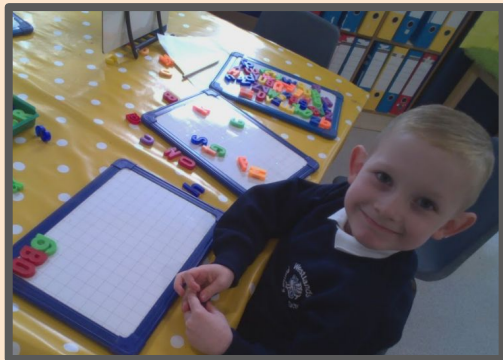


Oh no- we've got to go through it!
