
Celebrating Year

Year 2 has been working incredibly hard in their English lessons during Term 1.


They began the term by retelling some narratives around Space.

The children have been including lots of adjectives and expanded noun phrases.

They have also been using colourful semantics to help them with their retells.








In Term 1, Year 2 have been revisiting their number bonds learning before moving on to learning about the place value of ones and tens.

They have used a Concrete, Pictorial and Abstract approach to be able to demonstrate their understanding of number - Well done.

The children have also been practising their subitising skills to help them recognise numbers quicker.











During Term 1, Year 2 have been looking at animals, humans and their habitats.

First they considered what the difference was between living, non-living and never alive.

Next, they thought carefully about food chains and how this process works before making some of their own.






Over Term 1 in Curriculum Driver lessons, the children have learnt about 'Movers and Shakers'. They have learnt about who they were and what it takes to be referred to as a Significant Individual.

They have looked at timelines and different groups of people such as activists, explorers and scientists.











This term our focus in Art was to explore drawing.
