

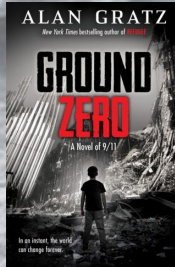
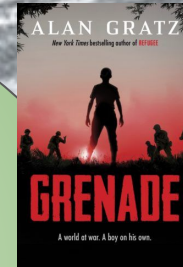
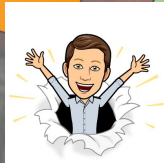
# Term 6 - Year 6

Please have a coat in school - even a raincoat for those drizzly play times please.

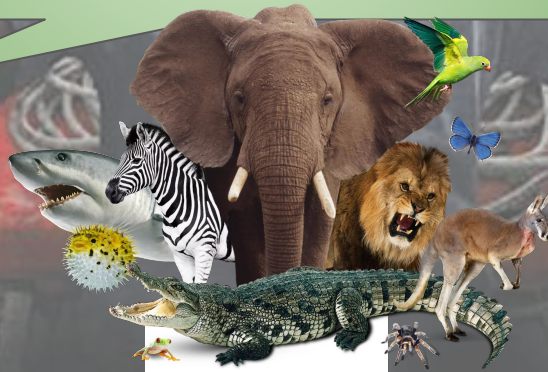
