It is important to note that in EYFS at Westlands Primary we teach to the children's interest so this plan may change. We offer a play based curriculum where children are encouraged to use the inside and outside learning environment on a daily basis, whatever the weather. We encourage our children to become independent learners in a safe and stimulating environment where staff plan activities around a different theme each term.





Personal Social and Emotional Development

Children will be working together in groups to recreate an experience and retell traditional tales. Role play areas will offer masks and props for children to express their ideas and interests with each other. We will talk about our favourite stories and explore the behaviour and attitudes of fairytale story characters. During this term staff will support and prepare the children for transition to year 1. Circle time discussions will offer time to ask questions and express their feelings about year 1.

Understanding of the world

This term we will be visiting Yew Tree Farm to see some farm animals. Take photographs and talk about our experiences. We will look at some maps of the farm and encourage the children to talk about what they can see on the map, the different areas and explaining new vocabulary. We will use the internet to research and find out more about the farm we are going to and how we will be traveling there.

Expressive Art and Design

Children will have the opportunity to explore ways of expressing their ideas through roleplay and art, they can mix stories up and think of their own storylines. We will use percussion instruments to make sounds to represent different animals and characters in the story. We will explore how to play an instrument and encourage the children to think about which instrument would best represent different part of

Physical Development

We will explore moving in different ways to represent different characters from a story. Children will be encouraged to construct with large equipment and junk modelling and build 'big' demonstrating their strength, balance and coordination whilst using tools and equipment safely developing motor control.

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Mathematics

During this summer term we are looking forward to consolidating the children's key skills. We will provide regular opportunities for the children to instantly recognise small quantities. Notice similarities and differences as they match and sort objects. We will provide regular opportunities for the children to practise and consolidate counting on and back within 10 and build in regular opportunities for the children to continue comparing and ordering quantities and measures as well as digging deeper to explore further. We will learn how to double, share and group. Learn about even and odd and explore spatial reasoning with fun activities for children to develop their understanding of pattern and relationships.

Communication and Language

The children will have the opportunity to share their favorite stories. We will encourage children to talk about what they can see and share their own ideas and understanding with each other.

Children will talk about what they would need to take with them on our school trip to the farm..

Literacy

The children will continue their daily phonics in the mornings and have the opportunity to apply their knowledge throughout the day; to write words and simple sentences. In the reading areas, a selection of traditional tale -themed books are available for the children to access and inform their discussions sharing new vocabulary. We will play alliteration games for children to practise letter recognition and letter sounds.
