

English

In English, over Term 6, the children will be writing an alternative ending to a Roman myth. They will also design and develop their own Roman God, which will appear in their own Roman story. Through enjoying a visit from a Roman workshop, the children will also write a recount of their experience.

Science

In term 6, the children will be exploring States of Matter. This will focus on solids, liquids and gases and the differences between them. We will use experiments to help us investigate the different states of matter.

History

During our Topic lessons, Year 3 will develop an understanding of The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. They will discover who Julius Caesar was and the British resistance to the Roman Reign. The children will also take part in a Roman workshop, when they visit during Term 6!

Maths

Over Term 6, Year 3 will be learning all about Time, Shape and Statistics. They will also be revisiting key mathematical operations and how to apply these to problem solving and reasoning questions.

DT

This term Year 3, will investigate pneumatic systems, using pressurised air to make objects move. We will use key vocabulary such as: motion, mechanisms, pneumatic, force, distance, systems, movement.

Computing

During computing lessons, the children will be learning how to design and write programs to achieve specific goals, including solving problems. They will develop their understanding of logical reasoning within computing.

French

In French, the children will learn how to count from 1 to 100 in French! They will also revisit core vocabulary such as greetings and colours.

Changing Me:

Over Term 6, the children will learn about how babies grow, babies, outside body changes, inside body changes, family stereotypes and looking ahead.
