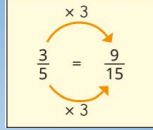
We will continue to read 'Freedom' by Catherine Johnson. Once finished, we will read part of 'Pig Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman.

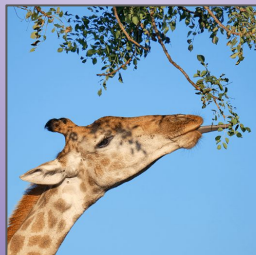
