Term One Year 4 Invasions

We have an exciting term ahead of us!

Science

We will be learning about 'Forces and Magnets', investigating friction by comparing how objects move on different surfaces, Also, observing how magnets attract and repel each other and identifying magnetic materials.

Maths

We will be following the White Rose maths curriculum.
We will be teaching 'place value' in numbers up to 10,000, looking at ordering, comparing and rounding.
We will then revisit addition, and subtraction methods with exchanging
There is a key focus on times tables in Year 4 with 'Times Table Time' section added to 3 lessons per week to embed multiplication and division facts.

P.E. will be on a Tuesdays and Thursdays for all classes.

History

During our History lessons, the children will learn about about life in Britain after the Roman withdrawal. Children will learn about Anglo-Saxon and Viking invasions up to the Norman conquest.

Computing

Throughout term one, we will focus on keeping ourselves and others safe whilst online. There will also be a focus on website searches and if we should believe everything we read online.

French
