Now our Year 6 children are in their final few weeks of primary school, I would like to give you some more information regarding the leavers' activities that will take place in the final week.

Date:	Activity:	Additional information:
Monday 18th July	Movie Night 4:30pm - 6pm	<p>Children are invited to come back into school from 4:30pm to watch a movie within their own classrooms. There will be a selection of U rated films that the children will choose from.</p> <p>Children are allowed to come into school in sensible, casual clothes. Clothing does still need to be appropriate, no crop tops etc.</p> <p>Snacks and drinks are allowed to be brought in by the children to eat throughout the evening. <b>No peanuts or fizzy drinks will be allowed to be consumed.</b> Children will not be allowed to share food.</p> <p><b><u>Arrival and dismissal will be from the blue stairs. If children usually have permission to walk home, they will not be able to do so at 6pm; they will need to be collected.</u></b></p>
Tuesday 19th July	Leavers' disco 4:30pm - 6pm	<p>Children can come back into school at 4:30pm. Children will enter via the main office.</p> <p>Non-uniform can be worn, but this will need to be appropriate clothing. No high heels, crop tops etc.</p> <p>Snacks and drinks will be provided for the children.</p> <p><b><u>Dismissal will be via the red stairs. If children usually have permission to walk home, they will not be able to do so at 6pm; they will need to be collected.</u></b></p>
Wednesday 20th July	Class party - in the afternoon	<p>Class parties will be in the afternoon during the school day. If children would like to bring in some party food, they may do so. Each individual child can bring in a selection of food and they will not be able to share. Children can bring their food in either a container or on a paper plate. <b>No peanuts or fizzy drinks will be allowed to be consumed.</b> Drinks will be provided.</p>
Thursday 21st July	Leavers' assembly 9:30am	<p>Leavers' assembly will be held in the main school hall and this will start at 9:30am. Once the assembly has come to an end, there will be an opportunity for parents to enjoy a hot drink and some cake with their child for a short period of time.</p>

We have had some enquiries regarding the signing of t-shirts on the last day of term. As a school we have decided that this will **not** take place. Children will be given their own autograph book on the last day of school, which they can all sign. Once children have left us at 3:10pm **and are off-site** with their parents/carers, the signing of shirts may be a decision that families choose to arrange individually once off the school premises.
