English -

Daily phonics lessons continue alongside our text based work around our woodland theme. We are focussing on writing super sentences which make sense, using a full stop/exclamation mark or question mark and capital letters in the right places. We will also learn about adjectives and verbs! We will act out stories using puppets and masks are retell them in our writing - maybe with a twist. We're also linking to Science and writing instructions on how to plant seeds.

Science - This term our science focus is plants. We will be looking at seasonal change, identifying and naming a variety of wild plants and common garden plants, labeling the different parts of a plant and of course we will be growing some plants too!
