

English

This term the children will experience a range of stories with a woodland theme. They will develop their skills in writing sentences using capital letters to begin and a full stop, exclamation mark or question mark. They will retell short stories using actions and gestures create their own versions.

Science

This term the children will develop their understanding of the natural world focussing on plants and the seasonal change from Winter to Spring.

They will learn the parts of a plant, grow vegetables and flowers from seed and conduct growth experiments over time. They will also discover what most plants need in order to grow.

Maths

The children will develop their knowledge and understanding of numbers to 50.

They will learn about Tens and Ones and learn to order and compare numbers including counting in 2s and 5s to 50. They will also learn to add and subtract within 50 and through measuring they will begin to learn about length, weight and volume.
