Dear Parent / Carer

In line with government policy, the School Health Service in partnership with your child's school offers children in year 6 the opportunity to complete a simple, secure, online questionnaire about their health, wellbeing, lifestyle choices and behaviour. This questionnaire will help to identify any support your child may need and is delivered in school. The questionnaire will be delivered in school on the 20<sup>th</sup> January 2022.

We will explain clearly to your child about the content of the questionnaire, and what we do with the information, to enable them to make an informed decision about completing it. No child will be made to complete the questionnaire if they don't want to – it's their choice. Following completion of the questionnaire your child may choose or be invited to speak to a member of the School Health Team in confidence virtually. This may result in a member of the team contacting you to offer guidance and support.

All personal information collected from this questionnaire will be treated as confidential and held securely to meet with data protection, GDPR and Information Governance requirements.

Your child's school will receive an anonymised data report to enable them to target healthcare action plans to meet the specific needs of the school community. Schools will not be able to identify individual
