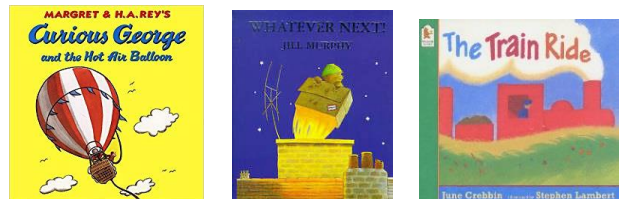
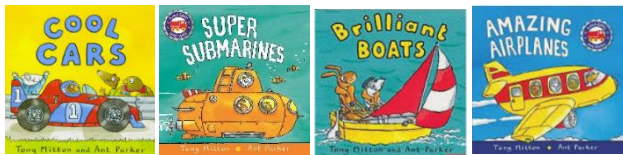
Understanding of the world
