Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to inform you of an exciting opportunity for our Year 4 pupils.

On Friday 14th July 2023 we will be taking Year 4 to Howletts Wild Animal Park, near Canterbury to support our Science learning.

The trip will leave at 9am and we aim to return to school at 4pm, this is to allow the children an extra hour to explore the park. The children will be dismissed from the usual doors at this time. Should we for any reason be running late, then the school will contact you via Weduc to inform you of this.

The cost of the trip will be £25. This covers both entry into Howletts and coach travel, which is proving to be quite expensive in present times. Payment for the trip is a voluntary contribution, however, if not enough monies are paid then unfortunately we will have to assess the viability of the trip and this could lead to cancellation. If you need support regarding making payments, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

The last day for payment will be Friday 30th June 2023.

Children will need to wear school uniforms with sensible footwear (i.e. trainers), bring a sun hat and also sun cream that they can apply themselves. If your child is entitled to free school meals then the school will provide a lunch, if not, then your child will need to bring their own.

There will not be an opportunity for children to visit the shop, therefore children do not need to bring any money.
