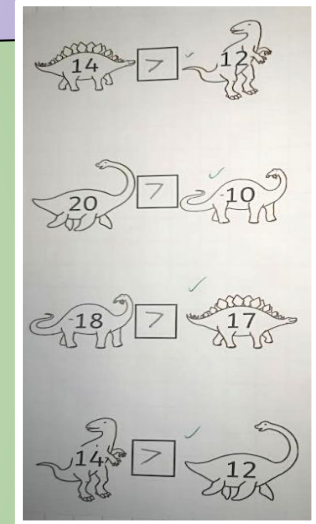
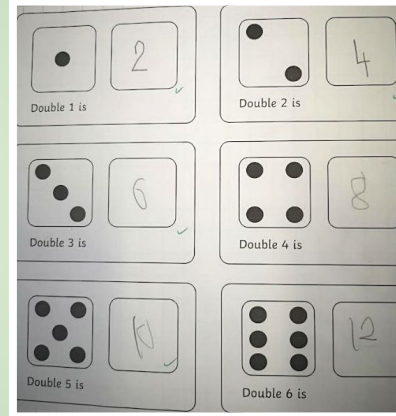
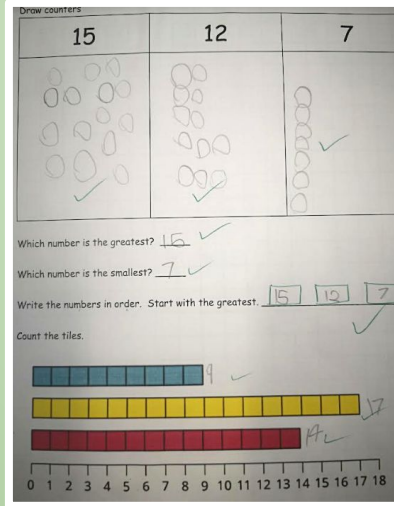
What an incredible term packed full of engaging learning based around our 'Dinosaur Planet' theme!

We've learnt how to add and subtract numbers within 20. We can use equipment to help us solve calculations. We especially enjoyed learning to double numbers!

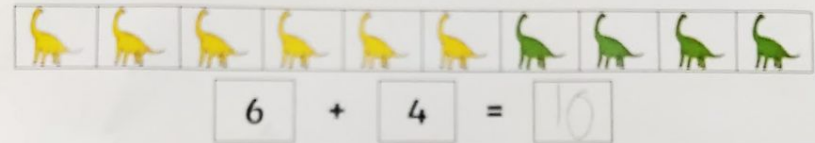
In Maths this term we have extended our counting skills and our understanding of the value of the digits in a number. We've learnt to compare and order numbers to 20 and beyond.



Dinosaur Colouring Number Bonds of 10 Activity

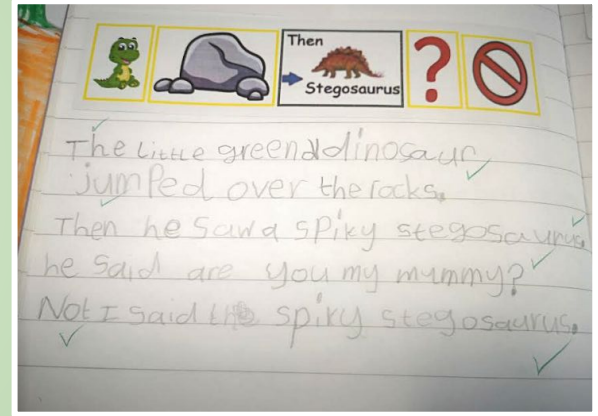
Choose two colours. Can you colour in the dinosaurs to create a number bond of 10?

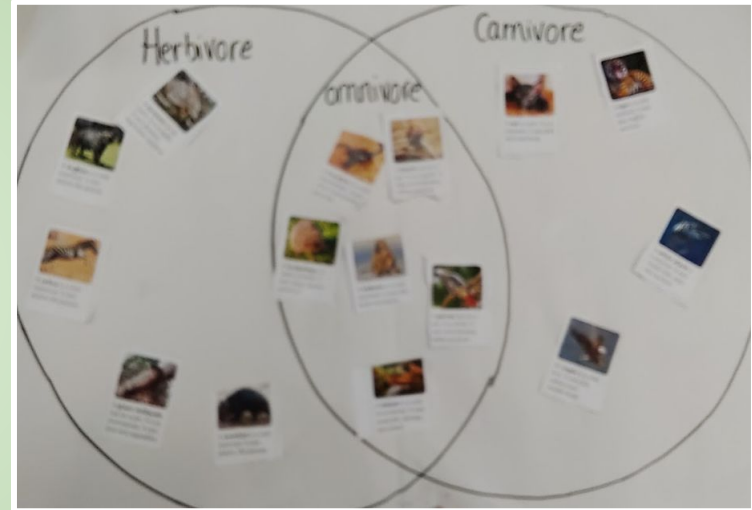
English
