
Over Term 3, the children have been learning how to write some amazing stories. They have written a version of Little Red Riding Hood and created their own twisted endings.

They wrote the stories alongside National Storytelling Week.







We have also focused upon our times tables.








During Term 3, children have been learning about rocks. We have discovered the different types of rocks and examples of these.

The children created their own colour wheels and learnt about primary and secondary colours.













In Religious Education this term, the children explored why the Bible is still important to Christians today.


The children learnt about how the words of the Bible still inspire songs, art and poetry and also how Jesus' parables are still meaningful today.
