Have a look at the following slides to see some examples of their amazing work!



The children wrote some excellent shape poetry and included many of the features.


The children then went on to writing an effective set of instructions.






The focus text for this term has been Around The World in Eighty Days. The children thoroughly enjoyed an adventure story!

In Term 4, the children learn all about fractions.


They learn about the numerator and denominator, fractions of shapes and numbers, unit fractions and non unit fractions.

done.









During Term 4, the children have been learning all about Rocks.

Year 3 also learnt about soil and the different layers of it.






Over Term 4, the children continued to learn about Rocks, Relics and Rumbles! They learnt about tsunamis and how they are formed and also about Human and Physical Geography.
