
Celebrating Year 3's Learning


Over Term 2, Year 3 have been developing their writing skills through a variety of genres. Our focus text for this term has been Stig of The Dump and some unseen factual texts. The children spent time considering the author's choice of words and the impact of these on the reader.







Celebrating Year 3's Learning

They have used a Concrete, Pictorial and Abstract approach to be able to demonstrate their understanding of number - Well done. We have also focused upon our times tables.








Celebrating Year 3's Learning


Over Term 2, the children continued to learn about The Stone Age, The Bronze Age and The Iron Age.


They developed their understanding of how Stone Age people lived and how the Iron Age developed areas in their lives such as weapons and jobs.

The children created some fantastic Murti from clay.










Celebrating Year 3's Learning
