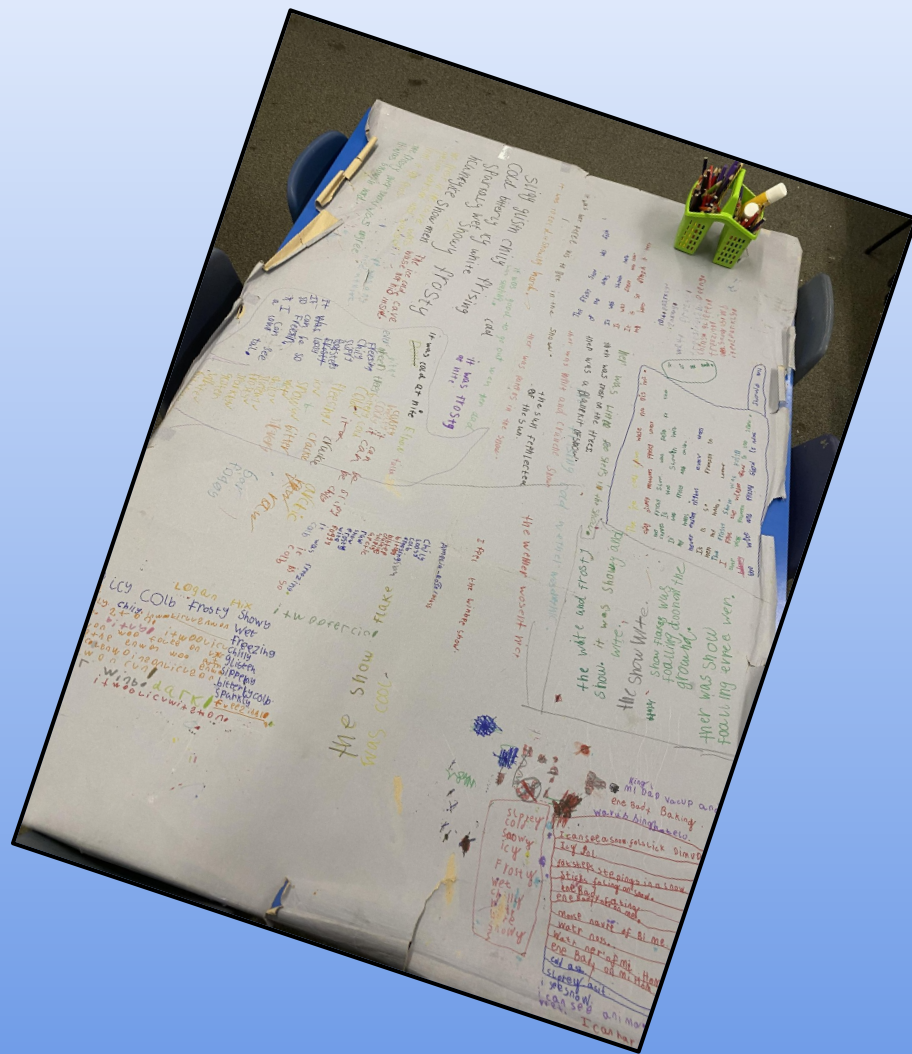


We are very proud of how well Year 2 have worked over the past term.

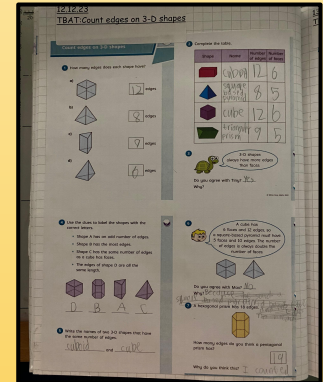
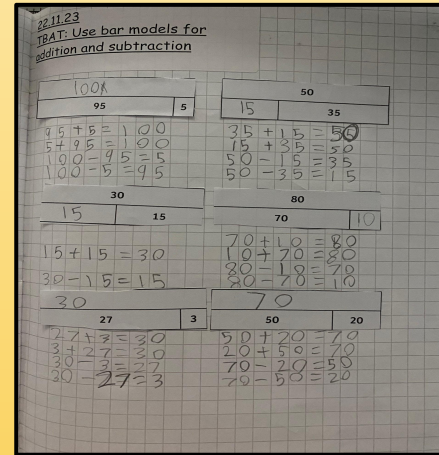
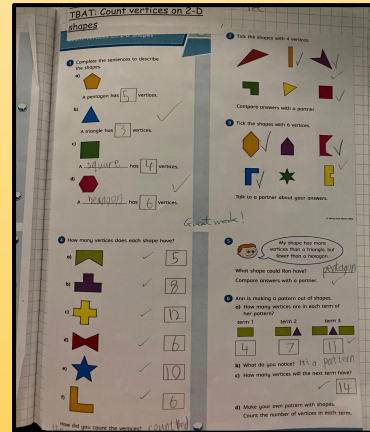
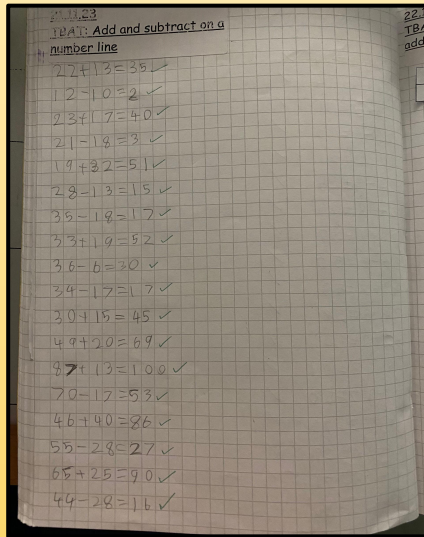


Celebrating Year 2's Learning

at Human Survival.

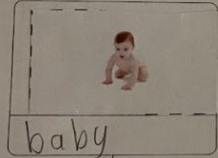
We have looked at the life cycle, exercise,

without soap.

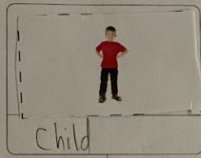
Stages of life



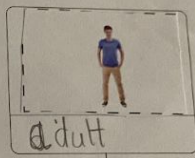
