

Term 2 in Year 1

This work shows a part-whole model using the number bond 6+2=8. The children have learnt about the fact families associated with this number bond.




In Maths this term we have been counting to 30 and using the part whole model and tens frames to add and subtract numbers to 20.

In English we have learnt about The Gunpowder Plot - we wrote safety rules for Bonfire Night!



These stories help the children to learn about the seasonal


changes and how animals adapt!




