

## English -

Daily phonics lessons continue alongside our text based work around our woodland theme. We are focusing on writing super sentences which make sense, using a full stop/exclamation mark or question mark and capital letters in the right places. We will also learn about nouns, adjectives and verbs! We will be explaining how to care for our forests, writing information posters as well using our Geography learning to write directions.

**Science** - This term our science focus is animals, particularly those we might find in woodlands. We will be investigating variation in animals such as butterflies and how amazing invertebrates are at burrowing!

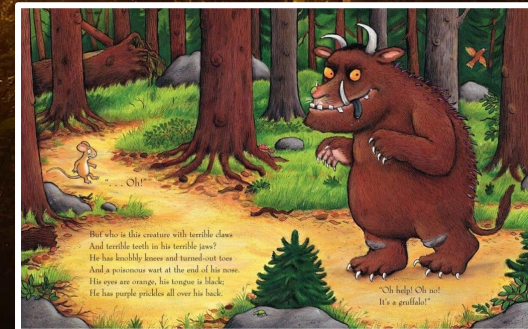
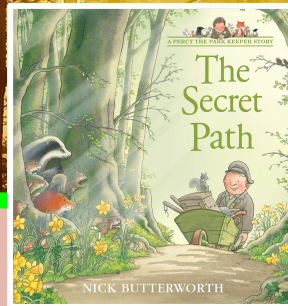
## Maths -
