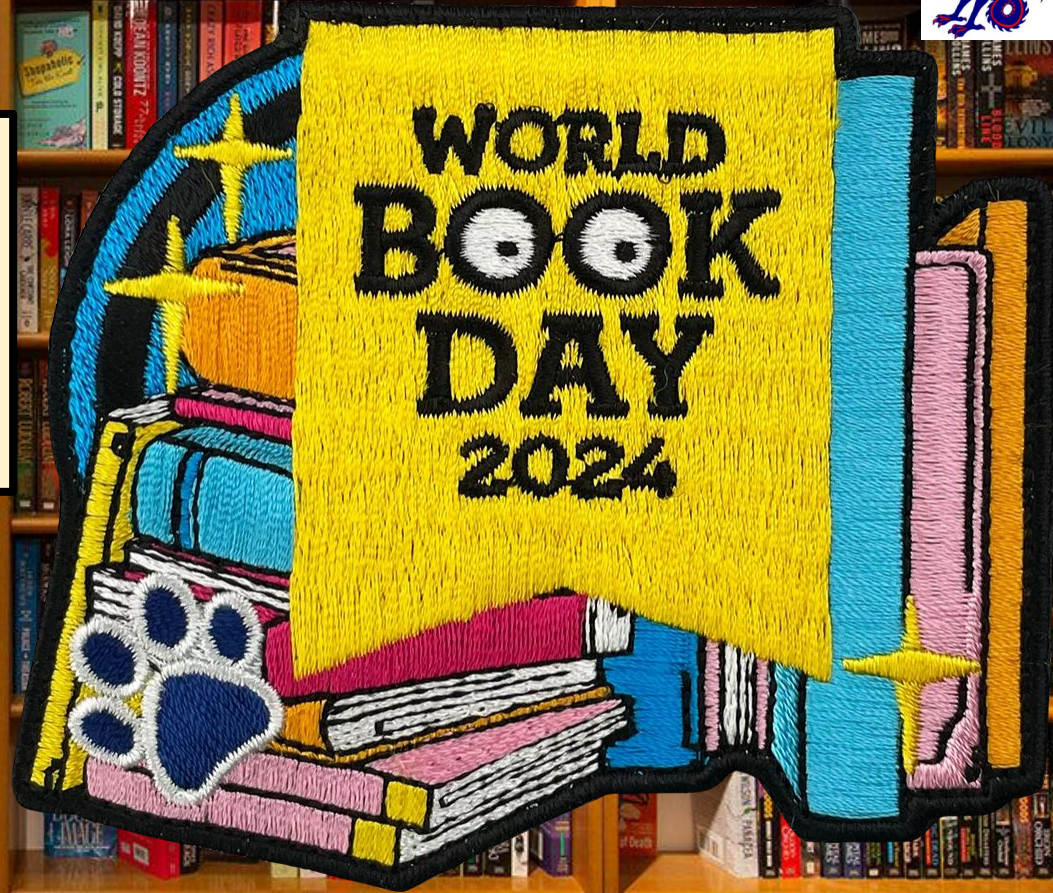


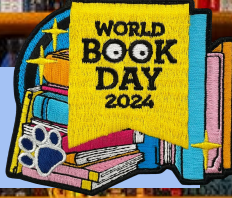

Create your own character and costume!

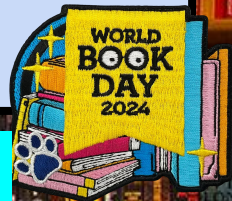
This World Book Day, children can create their own character and dress up as them for WB Day. In class, they will create a story using that character during the day.

Can you beat our previous winners and read in an unusual location?

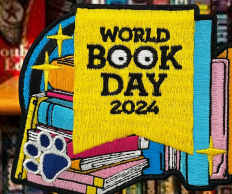


One winner per year group to receive a book plus 5 books for their class. Entries can be sent in on Class Dojo or via the School Office.

Book-in-a-Box

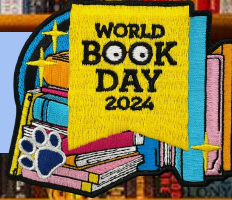
We will be running a competition for children to create their favourite book - inside a box!

Entrants must make a bookmark based around their favourite book. Include a quote from the book, maybe a favourite line or one you remember as part of the design.

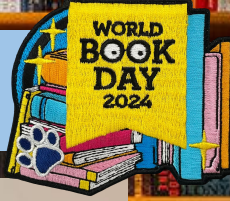
“Well, you would not believe what noises there are in the garden at night!”

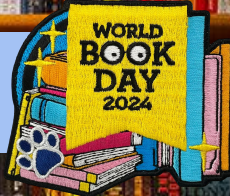
Masked Reader

Class book sharing.



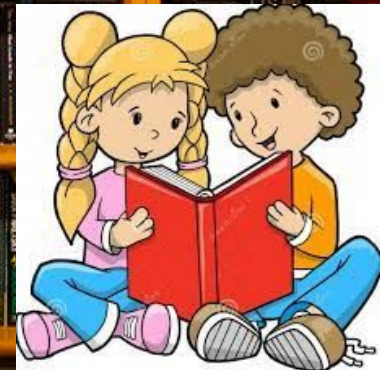
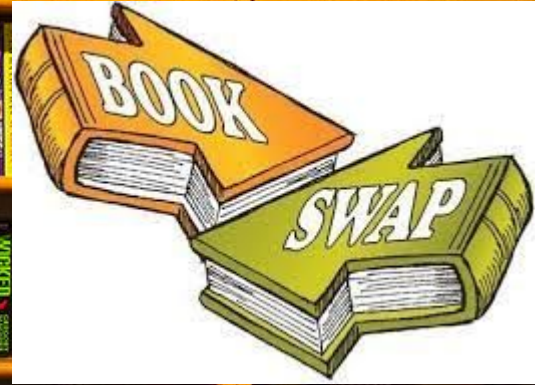
Classes paired across year groups will exchange books and read to one-another.

Year 6 and Year 3

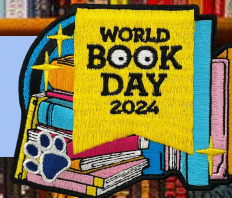
Year 5 and Year 2

This will also include the chance for your children to choose a mystery book to be added to your class library.

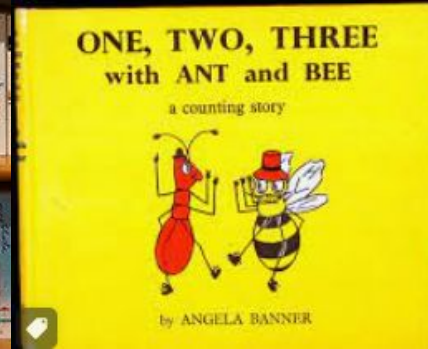


Teacher Child Book Match

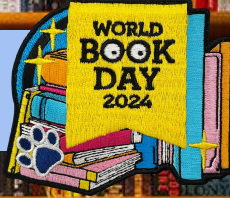


Can the children match the photos of the teachers as children to their favourite child's book from when they were young?

Jackanory Story Time

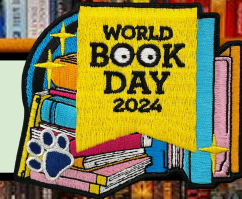


A look at how a master storyteller reads aloud to inspire the children.

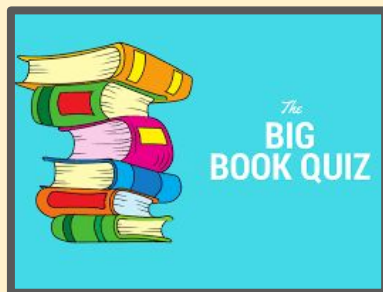

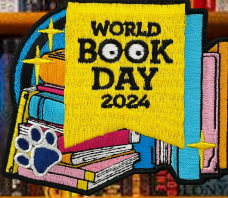
Book Quiz Competition
