poor.

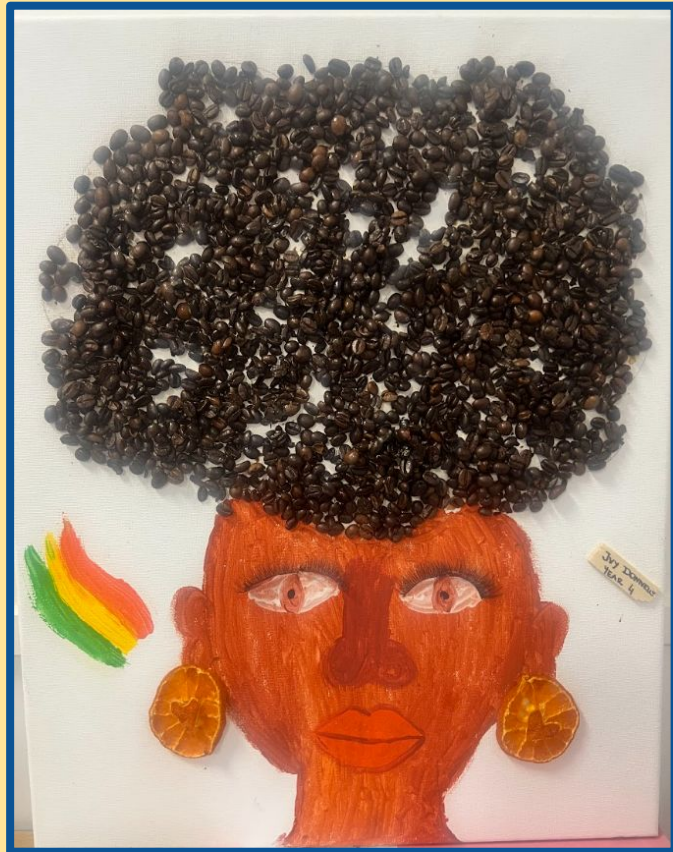

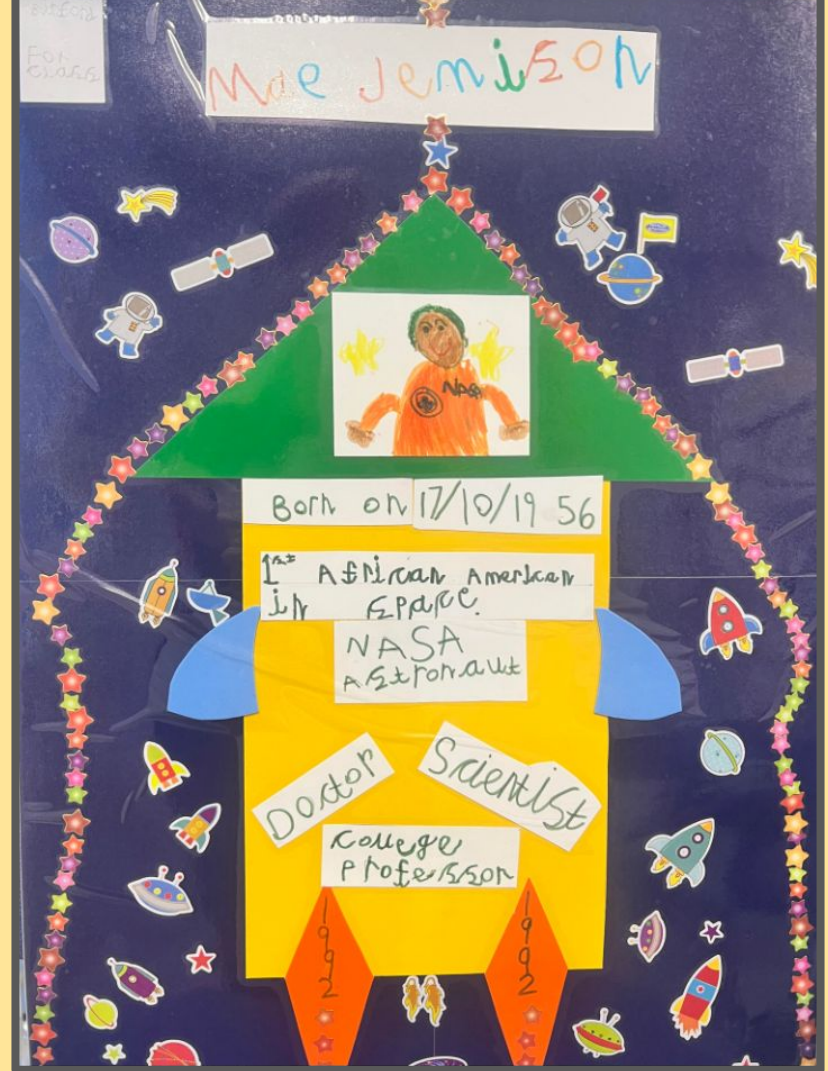

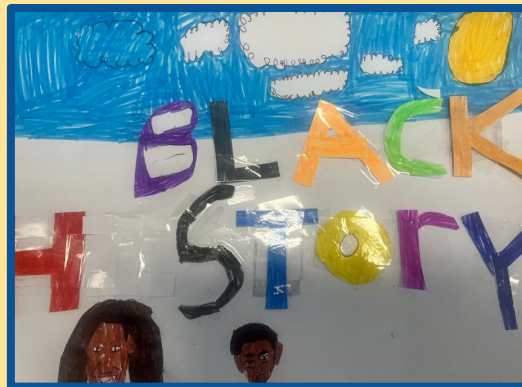
