Home Learning

English

In English, over Term 6, the children are going to be focusing on writing narratives, creating comic strips and learning how to write poetry still all linked to the Royal Family and London!

History

This project teaches the children about the English and British monarchy from AD 871 to the present day. Using timelines, information about royal palaces, portraits and other historical sources, they build up an understanding of the monarchs and then research six of the most significant sovereigns.

Maths

Within our Maths lessons, we will be exploring statistics including pictograms and bar graphs. We will then be moving on to look at time including telling the time within 5 minutes. We will be finishing the term exploring position and direction.

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Computing

Our focus for Term 6 will be online safety. The children will think about what is true and false if it is posted online and the sorts of things that should be shared.

Religious Education

Children will learn about different religious and spiritual ways of life about caring for other people and for the world.

Art

The children will be enjoying a weekly art lesson based around sculpture. Based on our RE focus, we will create a tile inspired by islamic art, including sprigs or relief and sgraffito details.

Science - *Animals and Living Things*

This project teaches children about growth in animals by exploring the life cycles of some familiar animals. They build on learning about the survival of humans by identifying the basic needs of animals for survival, including food, water, air and shelter.

PSHE - Changing Me

In this unit, the children will learn about changes in themselves and others. They will look at how every individual is unique and special and think about whether they are looking forward to change or have worries about this.

Physical Education

Our 6th 'Real PE' unit is a Health and Fitness. In this unit, the children will develop ball chasing and floor work balance through focused practised and competitive games.

Music

This unit will follow the structure of the past terms. They will listen and appraise classical music, continue to embed the foundations of the dimensions of music using voices and instruments and sing!
