Over Terms 5 and 6, Year 3 will write a range of different genres. They will learn how to write a letter, myths, poetry, descriptions and narratives.

They will develop their knowledge and understanding of writing techniques such as applying expanded noun phrases and sophisticated vocabulary.

Science
